

Energy Policy

- Increasing our energy efficiency
- Investing in energy efficient plant and new technologies

Through this commitment, we believe that we will be able to help the business' efficiency as well as reducing the environmental impact of our operations.

To meet these aims, the company will embark on a programme of continuous improvement for our energy use. This programme will include the following:

- Regularly surveying the main energy consuming parts of the company; mobile plant and generators in the quarries and the mines and saws in the factory
- Identify means for reducing the energy usage through better process, improved 'housekeeping' methods and new improved plant
- Recording and reporting the monthly energy usage and comparing the figures to our objectives

The policy will be implemented by the Operations Director through the Department Managers: Quarry & Mine Manager, Factory Manager, Engineering Manager and the Accounts Manager. They will also be responsible for promoting energy efficiency to all the staff and disseminating information about new programmes and initiatives. Energy awareness training will also be included as part of new staff inductions.
