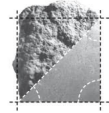
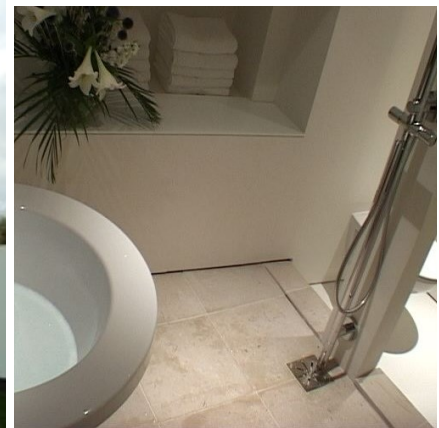
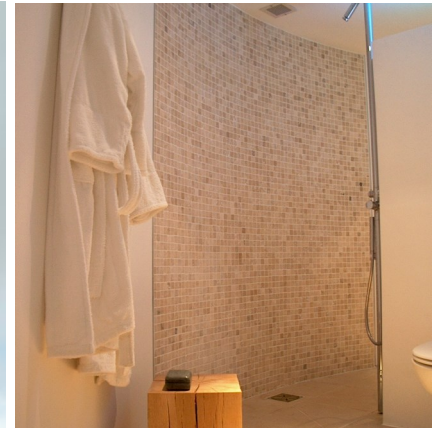

The project consisted of the restoration and conversion of the 130 year old Victorian stone water tower in the village of Lymm in Cheshire into a modern and stylish family living accommodation.
