14 Cornhill succeeds in combining the best characteristics of the existing building with the modern retail and Grade A office space required today.

The original building, now Grade II Listed, was built in 1929 to the designs of Tommy Tait. The imposing six-storey building sits on a triangular wedge between Lombard Street and Cornhill.

A small segment of the plot was taken up by another building, 13-14 Cornhill, which has recently been demolished behind a retained facade, creating a larger project footprint. The site address has now taken on this name and is officially rebranded as 14 Cornhill.

Albion Stone's masons produced the ornate hand-fix work using Portland Basebed. Albion Stone provided £170,000 of stone for this project.
